Kelmore's Waterproof Tape is a durable, self-adhesive tape designed to create a permanent waterproof seal at joints, junctions and fixing points. Used in conjunction with Kelmore Waterproofing Paste or suitable waterproof tile backer boards, it enables complete waterproofing of wet areas prior to tiling. This 100mm wide, butyl-rubber backed tape has a centrally split, removable backing paper to aid application in angled junctions. Easy to cut to size, it provides a reliable, waterproof seal in these vulnerable areas.

BACKGROUND AND SURFACE PREPARATION

Backgrounds must be dry and strong enough to carry the total weight being applied. All surfaces must be clean, sound and free from contaminants that could impair adhesion.

Application

Kelmore Waterproof Tape has a centrally split, removable backing paper which allows staged removal for ease of application.

- Pre-cut the tape to size using scissors or a utility knife.
- Peel off part of the split paper backing, place over the joint, junction or fixing point and press firmly into place.
- Continue to remove the paper backing whilst firmly pressing and smoothing the tape into place until all the paper has been removed and the tape is smooth and strongly adhered to the background.

NOTES:

- Kelmore Waterproof Tape must only be used on dry, internal backgrounds and is not suitable in areas subject to rising damp or negative water pressure.
- Do not use in areas of total water immersion such as swimming pools and storage tanks.

STORAGE Store in unopened packaging, off the ground, and in cool, dry conditions.

BS 5385 Kelmore Waterproof Tape should be used in conjunction with work carried out under the British Standard Code of Practice for Wall and Floor Tiling.
